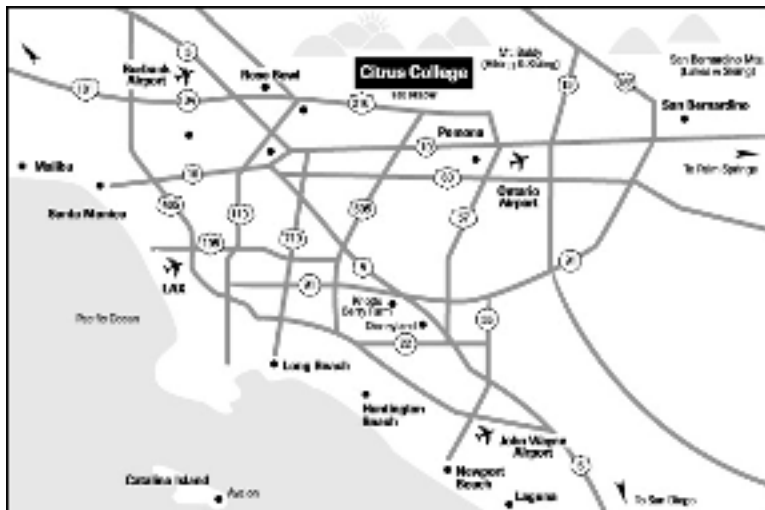

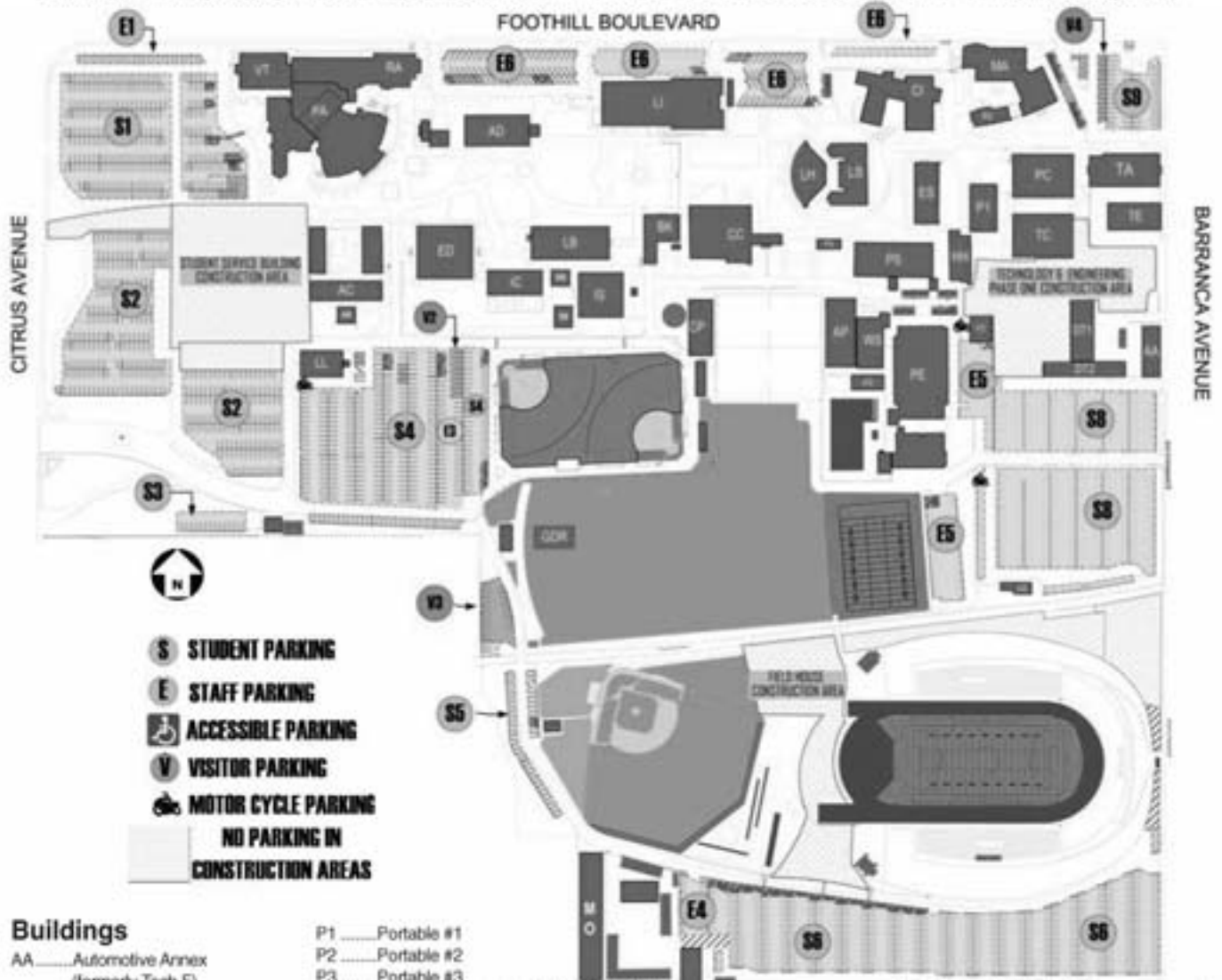

All visitors must display a parking permit available for \$5 from the parking vending machine, the information booth or the Security Office. Handicapped parking is available in every lot. To use handicapped parking, you must have a DMV placard or a handicapped parking permit issued by Disabled Students Programs and Services or the Security Office.

PARKING

Citrus College has strict parking rules and regulations. One-day parking passes will be provided to officials on game day. School and state vehicles and busses are exempt. All other vehicles including rentals must have a parking permit. Parking permits are available via an automatic kiosk in lot S8 for the gymnasium and stadium parking. You can also purchase day passes at the booth located at the Citrus Avenue entrance for the baseball and softball fields.

Parking Rules & Regulations:

- All vehicles must be parked in parking spaces front-end first. A citation is issued for failure to comply with this regulation.
- Campus speed limit is 15 miles per hour in all parking areas.
- Spaces for handicapped drivers are available in all campus lots. Vehicles using these spaces must display a valid DMV placard or temporary permit. The minimum fine for illegally parking in a handicapped space is \$330.00.
- All motorcycles, mopeds, motorized bicycles and scooters must park in areas designated for motorcycles.

WE CAN NOT VOID CITATIONS ONCE THEY ARE ISSUED. Parking regulations must be adhered to in all parking areas.

DRESSING & SHOWER FACILITIES BY SPORT

BASEBALL - Dressing and shower facilities are available in the training room area of the Main Gym

BASKETBALL - Dressing and shower facilities are available in the locker room adjacent to the gym for men, and in the building west of the gym for women.

CROSS COUNTRY - Dressing and shower facilities are available in the Field House for men, and in the women's locker room for women.

FOOTBALL - Dressing and shower facilities are available in the Field House.

SOCCER - Dressing and shower facilities are available in the Field House for men, and in the women's locker room for women.

SOFTBALL - Dressing and shower facilities are in the women's locker room adjacent to the gymnasium.

SWIMMING - Dressing and shower facilities are located in the Citrus College Aquatics Center for both men and women.

TRACK & FIELD - Dressing and shower facilities are available in the Field House for men, and in the women's locker room for women.

VOLLEYBALL - Dressing and shower facilities are in the women's locker room adjacent to the gymnasium.

ATHLETIC TRAINING

Welcome to Citrus College! We are having construction on campus and our Athletic Training facilities may move throughout the year. Currently, we plan on having football, soccer, and track athletic training services available in our new field house located northwest on the stadium. Baseball and softball athletic training services will be provided on the fields, unless otherwise requested by the visiting ATC prior to the competition.

Volleyball, basketball, and any other sports will be treated in the Physical Education building, room 803, adjacent to the gymnasium. Parking lot E5 is most accessible to the gymnasium and PE buildings; the parking lots south of the stadium, S6 and E4, are most accessible for stadium and baseball (if no parking is available in S5). Access to the softball field is best from parking lot S4.

All home events are covered by an Athletic Trainer. Student Athletic Trainers may also be assigned events. In the case of multiple home events on the same day, the high risk sports will have direct coverage and on-call communication will be available for the other events. Physician coverage will be provided at all home football games.

If your team is traveling with a Certified Athletic Trainer, our facilities and modalities, including electrical stimulation and ultrasound, will be available for use. However, if you are not sending an athletic trainer, or you are sending a student, we ask that they bring a prescription from either an ATC or a team physician for modality use or any other specific services. We ask that contact with the hosting athletic trainer be made if you have any special requests.

Our athletic training room will be open 1.5 hours prior to a home event, and will close 30 minutes after the event. We will perform any taping or first aid care that is recommended, however, please provide all supplies needed. During the event, your team will have access to emergency care equipment and an AED, and will be provided ice, water, and cups/bottles. Please address any questions or requisitions to any of our trainers.
