College Admission

Admission to Citrus College is open to high school graduates and any person 18 years of age or over.

Provide sealed official transcripts of all previous college and high school work, if applicable.

Assessment of English and math skills is required for all new students planning to enroll in more than 5 units or planning to complete an associate degree or higher. For assessment information, contact the Counseling and Advisement Center.

Concurrent Enrollment for High School Students

Some programs and classes are available for current junior and senior high school students. Interested high school students should contact their high school counselor or the college's Admissions and Records Office.

Associate Degree

For an associate degree, you must complete a minimum of 60 units including a minimum of 18 units in your major, a minimum of 22 units of general education, a minimum of 17 units of electives and satisfy the physical education requirement.

Please note: Only courses numbered 100-299 may apply toward the associate degree.

Transfer Requirements

Transfer requirements can be integrated with the associate degree option so that you may receive a degree at the time of transfer. **See a counselor for specific requirements for your major. Course requirements may vary among colleges.**
