## SHARED GOVERNANCE

In accordance with Title 5 and the Education Code, Citrus Community College District encourages shared governance. Shared governance is the process by which Citrus College constituents: the Board of Trustees, faculty, managers, classified staff, supervisors/ confidential team, and students promote wise and timely decisions. The preservation of shared governance requires the commitment of all personnel to keep the channels of communication open. Participation in shared governance is a job-related expectation of all employees.

While legal authority to adopt policy rests with the Board of Trustees, the District embraces shared governance as a method of seeking broad participation in conflict resolution, effective communication, and formation and implementation of district policy. The Board of Trustees acknowledges matters listed in Title 5 and delegates approval and administration of such matters to the Superintendent/President.

Shared governance does not necessarily imply total agreement nor the same degree of involvement by all participants. The ultimate responsibility for decisions rests with the Board of Trustees.
