Indicator 2: COURSE COMPLETION: Course completion is the ratio of number of credit courses in Math and Science that Citrus College students completed by the end of term, compared to the number of courses in which students are enrolled on census day of that term. “Course completion” is defined as successful completion of a credit course with a recorded grade of A, B, C, or Credit.
