

Below is a sampling of scholarships available through the Citrus College Foundation. Not all scholarships listed below are available every year and new scholarships become available throughout the year.

Transfer Scholarships (awarded spring semester to students transferring to a four-year college or university the upcoming fall semester)

Deborah J. Anthony Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$300 scholarship

Student with disabilities attending Citrus during spring semester; graduate and/or transfer student who has met requirements for a bachelor's degree; has been accepted for summer or fall enrollment in a university or vocational school; financial need.

Citrus College Faculty Association Scholarship

2 - \$500 scholarships

Citrus student enrolled in 9 units or more spring semester, transferring to a four year institution; 3.0 GPA or better; financial need.

Michael David Dittmore Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$2,500 scholarship

Intended for an outstanding chemistry, biology, or chem-bio student transferring to a 4-year institution. Must have 4.0 in major (though not overall.) Student should display dedication to studies and excellence in sciences. Department will have input in selection of recipient. Students returning to school after spending time at a 4-year college are encouraged to apply.

Gene Dudley Leadership Scholarship

1 - \$1,000 scholarship

Student must have demonstrated leadership and been active in student government and/or campus service organizations; must have completed a 2-year associate degree and be transferring to a four-year institution in upcoming summer or fall semester to pursue a BA or BS; 3.0 GPA or better.

General Biology Transfer Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Recipient must have completed Biology 105 (General Biology) with a letter grade of "B" or better; must be transferring to a four-year institution in upcoming summer or fall semester.

H. Vince Kelly Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$2,000 scholarship

Awarded to student planning to transfer to a four-year institution in the summer or fall; must have shown consistent academic progress and must plan to teach; emphasis in mathematics education is preferred but not required.

Maxine King Scholarship

1 - \$1,000 scholarship

Awarded to a student with financial need who is transferring to a four-year institution.

Patricia L. Knox Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$2,000 scholarship

Citrus June graduate with high GPA transferring to an accredited nursing school; seeking a BS in nursing.

Latina Leadership Network Scholarship

2 - \$400 scholarships

Awarded to a Latina/Latino student who is transferring to a four-year institution; 2.5 GPA or higher; involved in leadership. One award is intended for an AB540 student and one for a non-AB540 student but both will be awarded to non AB540 students if an AB540 qualified candidate is not identified. LLN will have input in the selection. Member of LLN preferred.

Betty Holt May Scholarship

4 - \$500 scholarships

Citrus June graduate transferring to a four-year institution; 2.5 GPA; shows an interest in education; involved in campus activities.

Dr. Bill May Scholarship

4 - \$500 scholarships

Citrus June graduate transferring to a four-year institution; 2.5 GPA; involved in campus activities and affiliated with athletics; baseball or football preferred.

Scott Alan Thompson Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$1,000 scholarship

Priority given to a male student enrolled in the recording studio, recording arts, or entertainment technology program, but open to any male student enrolled in a music program. Recipient must be transferring to a four-year institution in upcoming summer or fall semester to pursue a major in recording or performing arts, or in music.

Wal-Mart Boots to Books Veteran Transfer Scholarship

1 - \$2,500 scholarship

Student must be a United States veteran with a minimum 2.0 GPA who has successfully completed or is currently enrolled in the Boots to Books course at Citrus College and is transferring to a 4-year school in upcoming summer or fall semester.

Merrill West Memorial Alumni Association Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Recipient must be a June graduate who is transferring to a four-year institution in upcoming summer or fall semester; pursuing a degree in business or business management; financial need.

Scholarships for New and/or Continuing Students

Anson Communications Scholarship

2 - \$300 scholarship

2.5 GPA or better; financial need; single parent preferred.

Bright Futures Scholarships and Book Vouchers

A separate paper application is required for this scholarship. Forms are available in the Foundation Office or through counselors at district high schools. This scholarship is for incoming freshmen attending district high schools only.

24 - \$500 scholarships

Student graduating from a district high school and enrolling in upcoming summer or fall semester; should have 2.3 GPA or better and have participated in school or community activities.

BWEG Scholarship

1 - \$250 scholarship

Honor student preferred but not required. Re-entry student preferred but not required.

Intended for students between the ages of 18 – 28 years old.

California Retired Teachers Association (CRTA) Scholarship

2 - \$500 scholarships

Recipient must be enrolled in Teacher Prep program and must submit at least one faculty recommendation letter. Recipient should not be receiving another Citrus College Foundation scholarship during the fiscal year. Should demonstrate financial need.

Zachariah Michael Carter Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Student should have financial need (low-income family); 3.0 GPA or better.

Commander Gerfen's Military Scholarship

4 - \$500 scholarships

Recipient must be enrolled in, or have completed, the Boots to Books class; must have a GPA of 2.3 or greater; must be a veteran of the United States Armed Forces. Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from a Citrus College faculty member.

Michael David Dittmore Memorial Scholarship

2 - \$500 scholarships

One scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding student enrolled in the EMT program and one will be awarded to an outstanding student in the nursing program. Department input is part of the selection process.

Glendora Kiwanis Club

2 - \$500 scholarships

Glendora resident; continuing student; involved in leadership; financial need.

Dr. Jeanne Hamilton Leadership Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Merit-based; recipient must have 3.5 GPA or better and demonstrate leadership skills on campus or in the community.

Ross Handy Memorial Alumni Scholarship

1 - \$300 scholarship

Membership in campus or community service organizations preferred; continuing full-time student; must have completed 12 units or more; 2.5 GPA.

Jim Henderson Alumni Scholarship

1 - \$300 scholarship

Membership in campus or community service organizations preferred; continuing full-time student; must have completed 12 units or more; 2.5 GPA.

Lois and Clyde Henley Scholarship

1 - \$300 scholarship

Continuing Citrus student who has completed 12 or more units; 3.0 GPA; interest in art, PE or humanities.

Tom Hippie Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Awarded to a student enrolled in the cosmetology program. Financial need preferred.

Mary E. LaFetra Memorial Scholarship

4 - \$500 scholarships

Continuing Citrus students (single parents) enrolled in 9 units or more fall semester; 2.0 GPA or better.

Latinos Unidos Student Association (LUSA)

1 - \$250 scholarship

Must be a full-time student with a 2.5 GPA or better; active participation in LUSA.

Frank Magliocco Scholarship

1 - \$250 scholarship

Music major enrolled in vocal or instrumental music program, with a 2.5 GPA or better.

The McVey Family Scholarship

1 - \$250 scholarship

Full-time student enrolled in 12 units or more; single parent or from a single-parent family; can be enrolled in a vocational field; 2.8 GPA or better; financial need.

Albert and Georgia Meissenburg Scholarship

1 - \$250 Scholarship

Should be awarded to a deserving student who does not meet the specific criteria of other scholarships. Preference given to a graduate of Monrovia High School.

Clara Moyer Memorial Scholarship

2 - \$500 scholarships

Awarded to female re-entry student who is a single parent with financial need; displaced homemakers; 2.0 GPA or better.

Kathryn M. Powell Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Student must have a 2.5 GPA or better and has financial need.

Rasmussen Family Scholarship

1 - \$350 scholarship

Awarded to a student with financial need or academic achievement; minimum 2.5 GPA required.

Readers to Leaders Book Scholarship

Number and amounts vary

Awarded to a student who is currently enrolled at Citrus College and has successfully completed 12 hours at Citrus; must have a GPA or at least 2.5 and cannot be receiving EOP&S aid. Must have a current ASCC sticker.

Margaret Hayden Rector & Robert Wayman Rector Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Female student interested in theatre/playwriting, ancillary of theatre.

Marc G. Roberts Accounting Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Awarded to a student with financial need or academic achievement who is enrolled in accounting classes and has demonstrated an interest in a career in accounting or business; minimum 2.5 GPA.

Dr. Arnold Rollin Emerging Leadership Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Awarded to a continuing student who is active in and currently enrolled in student government; must have completed a least one semester at Citrus College.

Tony Russo Memorial Scholarship

2 - \$500 scholarships

Continuing student who has an interest in a career in athletic training or physical therapy.

Eleanor Thatcher Scholarship

1 - \$250 scholarship

Should be awarded to a deserving student who does not meet the specific criteria of other scholarships. Preference given to a graduate of Monrovia High School.

Watson Family Scholarship

5 - \$500 scholarships annually

Students enrolled in minimum of 9 units for spring semester; 2.0 GPA; must be a student parent; have declared academic or vocational goal; must demonstrate financial need (84 percent of state median income as published in the Family Fee Schedule issued by the Child Development division); must show progress toward achieving an educational goal; must have completed one semester at Citrus; fall recipients NOT eligible for spring scholarship.

Dr. Louis E. Zellers Scholarship

1 - \$250 scholarship

Awarded to a student who has demonstrated leadership on campus or in the

community; 2.5 GPA or better.

Department Scholarships

Adapted Physical Education

Dale C. Baird Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Must be current or past Adapted PE/Adapted Aquatics student, or current or past instructional aide in either area. Department selects.

Kathie Kilmer Scholarship

1 - \$250 scholarship

Awarded to a disabled student who is a current or past Adapted PE/Adapted Aquatics student who wants to further his/her education. Minimum 3.0 GPA; Adapted PE staff will select.

Biological Sciences

Edmund C. Jaeger Biological Sciences Scholarship

1 - \$250 scholarship

Open to all Citrus College biological sciences majors; based on academic standing; interest in biological field; intent of purpose and character; financial need; department selects.

Business

Gene Pribble Memorial Scholarship

2 - \$500 scholarships

Awarded to a student who is majoring in business (accounting, pre-law, real estate, etc. are acceptable) and planning to transfer to a 4-year institution to pursue a degree. Student should have a 3.0 in business courses.

English

Joan E. White Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Awarded to a student with financial need who is majoring in English. Selection will be made by English faculty.

Writing Skills Scholarship

2 - \$250 scholarships

Awarded to students who have completed English 100 with a grade of "A." Applicants must submit an essay stating why they feel they deserve a scholarship and what they hope to gain from it.

ESL

Cynthia Cross ESL Excellence in Writing Scholarship

1 - \$300 scholarship

Awarded to a student enrolled in the ESL program who presents the best written work within a given theme. Theme will vary each year. **A SEPARATE APPLICATION IS REQUIRED FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP. ESSAY INFORMATION SHOULD BE OBTAINED FROM ESL DEPARTMENT AND RETURNED TO ESL DEPARTMENT.** Selection will be made by ESL faculty.

Health Occupations

Anna Geleris Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$250 scholarship

Citrus student enrolled in Nursing, Medical Assisting or Dental Assisting program; recommendation of Health Occupations Department and teacher evaluation.

Journalism

Dave Barton Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Designated for *Clarion on-line* editor.

Rawson/Grindstaff Scholarship

1 - \$500 scholarship

Designated for Clarion editor

Music

Otto & Gladys Baumann Memorial Scholarship

1 - \$300 scholarship

Full time student enrolled in music program; must have financial need; department selects.

Howard Braun Memorial Music Scholarship Fund

1 - \$500 scholarship

Full-time continuing student in instrumental music programs; exemplary talent in instrumental music; 3.5 GPA or better; financial need.
